HOSW DELEGATES with a criminal record

The US immigration rules that convictions for certain crimes may make you ineligible to travel to the Hawaii. The only way to know for sure if your criminal record makes you ineligible is to apply for a visa. Only a consular officer can determine your visa eligibility. Please note that New Zealand's Clean Slate Act does not apply to U.S. visa law. If you have a criminal record and attempt to travel without a visa, you may be refused entry into the United States. Navigator Tours is offering two packages. These have arrivals in Hawaii closest to the start date of the event, 3rd September 2010. There are only three flights a week to Hawaii from Auckland and only two are suitable in terms of the Gathering. Visit www.hosw.co.nz now and make your booking.
